Department Highlights

Press Releases

The New 2016 Cruiser has been lettered to reflect Somerset County Sheriff's Office-Madison Division, and is currently at Yankee Communications to have the radio equipment installed. The 2015 Cruiser has also been re-lettered, and is currently being used as the primary vehicle. The 2014 has been stripped of the lettering, and is now the unmarked. The 2013 has been traded in at Hight Ford.

June 11th Corporal Eugene Cole, along with Deputies Wacome, Jackson, and Merry all responded to a report of an underage party complaint on the Blackwell Hill Rd. Deputies needed to call for an ambulance for a female that had passed out, they were told she had taken a drug call DAB (aka Butane hash oil from cannabis), with the alcohol. Deputies issued six juvenile summons' for minor consuming alcohol, and one adult summons for furnishing a place for minors to consume alcohol. Deputy Chelsea Merry is the primary investigator.

June 24th Deputies Libby, Wacome, Jackson, and Armiger all responded to a Loud Party complaint on Crazy Lane. They located a male subject who had an active warrant, and took the subject into custody. They also issued three additional summons' for minor consuming alcohol. Deputy Lucas Libby is the primary investigator.

June 24th Deputy Lafreniere did an OUI detail from the hours of 20:00-24:00, that resulted in a summons for the arrestable offense of Failure to register a vehicle over 50 days.

The Madison Division portables have all been upgraded to Motorola XPR 7000 series. The Sheriff has made an arrangement with the Madison Fire Department, to reallocate the previous Kenwood Portables for their use in the Fire Department.
